**Format for the day**

Coffee on arrival from 8.00am.

First tee-off at 9.00am

First round of 9 holes followed by soup & sandwiches.

Tee-off for final 18 holes from 12 noon

Steak & ale pie with potatoes & vegetables from 4pm, followed by presentations at approximately 5.30pm - 6pm.

Dress code for the Clubhouse is smart casual. No collarless shirts, jeans or trainers.

**The Competitions**

MAIN Competition - 27 hole team Stableford.

All teams to play all three courses and all players will play their own ball on each of the 27 holes.

Scoring: On Stroller (Yellow) the best two scores to count on each hole. On Needles (Blue) the best three scores to count on each hole. On Becton (Red) all four scores to count on each hole.

The winners will be the team with most points after all three rounds.

All players to play off 3/4 handicap

Stableford scoring system: 1 point for a net bogey, 2 points for a net par, 3 points for a net birdie, 4 points for a net eagle, 5 points for a net albatross.
